Michael West, author of Wide Game, Cinema of Shadows, Poseidon’s Children, Spook House, Vampires Don’t Sparkle! and Skull Full of Kisses will also be signing his books at the hotel on Saturday, August 17 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. in Circle City Bar & Grille.

The hotel will also be serving cocktails inspired by his writings.

“I love creating new worlds and new characters to live in those worlds. When I write, it’s like I’m watching this amazing movie play out in my mind and I’m trying to get it all down on paper so other people can enjoy it too,” said West.
